ENV27/015 Environmental Sub-Committee Works Update

The Chairman referred the Sub-Committee to the Grounds Maintenance Works Update, which had been enclosed with the agenda for the meeting.

The Chairman highlighted the following points:

- Allotments and removal of asbestos – Confirmation that this was progressing.

- Town Borders – the Grounds Maintenance Contractor had dealt with the borders as required.
- Grounds maintenance (installation of lock gate on Walton Roundabout) – it was confirmed that delivery is pending.
- Environmental initiatives (improvements to alleviate flooding) – The Chairman said that the Grounds Maintenance Contractor had not yet been able to start the work.
